| This study explores how Christians live their conviction of gender equality in a partnership|

I am seeking Christian couples who embrace gender equality in their relationship and may identify as **egalitarian**. This study relies on the following definition of egalitarian: the position that women and men are of equal, intrinsic value before God; there are no gender-based limitations of what functions or responsibilities each can fulfil in the home, church, or society.

Participants need to be willing to voluntarily participate in a one hour long **in-person or Skype interview** at a time and/or venue convenient to them and one short follow up Skype interview 6 months later. Participants have the option of being interviewed together as a couple, or separately at first followed by a short joint interview.


